We educate key players within local communities regarding the needs of Veterans, offering solutions to problems, suggestions and ideas, advocacy, signposting and practical help.



Your Veterans' Champion can also help. A Veterans' Champion is an elected member of the council with an interest in the Armed Forces Community.

Veterans' Champions have good knowledge of local services and are a first point of contact for Veterans who need information, signposting, or referral. They can also identify and advise local charities who may be eligible to apply for funding from the Armed Forces Covenant Fund Trust.

VETERANS' PLACES, PATHWAYS, AND PEOPLE PROGRAMME

Part of the Veterans' Mental Health and Wellbeing Fund

We are the Regional Lead for the Veterans' Places, Pathways and People Programme. This funding, from the Armed Forces Covenant Fund Trust, will support Veterans' mental health through the delivery of our Northern Ireland Vital Veterans' Network.

We will work with partner organisations to deliver regional psychology and psychiatry services, connect Veterans with mental health navigators and care coordinators, and offer training for front line volunteers within organisations.
